**Delivery of Original Works:** To Uxbridge Municipal Building, 51 Toronto Street South (use upper or lower entrance) on Sunday, Sept 16 between noon and 5:00 pm or Monday, Sept 17 between 10:00 am and noon.

**Gala Opening Reception:** Tuesday, Sept 18, 7:30 to 9:30 pm.

**Exhibition Dates:** Tuesday, Sept 18 – Saturday, Sept 22, 10:00 am to 6:00 pm and Sunday, Sept 23rd – 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

**Pick up Exhibited works:** Sunday, Sept 23 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

Works must be picked up on Sunday, Sept 23, no later than 4:00 pm. Works are no longer insured after Sept 23, and we will not be responsible for their safety.

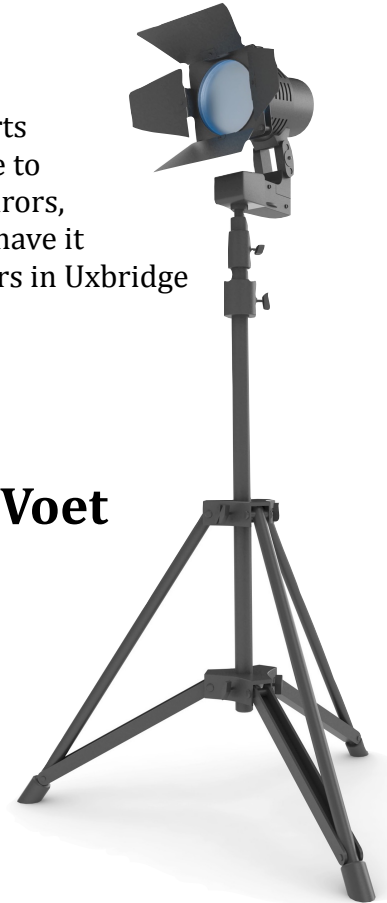

## Conditions of Entry - 2018

1. The distance requirement from Uxbridge has been eliminated.
2. All work must be designed and created by the entrant (no commercial kits or patterns) and completed after October 1, 2016.
3. All media will be eligible.
4. There is a non-returnable jurying fee of \$35.00 per artist.
5. Submission form and images are submitted online at [www.celebrationofthearts.ca/juried](http://www.celebrationofthearts.ca/juried). Up to 3 pieces may be submitted for consideration by the jury, with up to 3 images for each work. Images will be viewed on a 60" flat panel, so a minimum resolution of 2,000 pixels in JPG format is recommended. On 2D work, such as a painting, it is suggested to submit an overall photo as well as one or two shots of interesting detail in the work.
6. Each submission must have the artist name, title, date of work, size of work in inches, medium and artist's statement.
7. Works chosen for the exhibition must be delivered on Sept 16 or 17. Two-dimensional works should be ready to hang, mounted or framed, and with hanging wire.
8. Works must be delivered by the artist or designate. Works sent via a delivery service will not be accepted.
9. The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts will insure the works on its premises from Sunday, Sept 16 through Sunday, Sept 23 at 4:00 pm. Works will not be insured during transit.
10. The jurors reserve the right to disqualify any work that is misrepresented by the image used in the jurying process.
11. The jury's decision is final. No entry may be withdrawn once it has been accepted.
12. The artist grants the Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts the right to photograph accepted works for publicity, educational and reference purposes.

## How to submit your work

**Submission Deadline:** Submission form, payment and images must be received by the Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts by Aug 4, 2018

**Step 3.** Submit Pictures online

**Each submission will receive an email confirmation.**

**Sale of Works:** The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts will retain a 20% commission on all sales. Works are not required to be for sale. Selling price is set in the submission form.

Purchasers' cheques for the works sold must be made payable to "Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts."

- **Best Painting \$125** (including drawing, collage, etc.)
- **Best Sculpture \$125**
- **Best Photography \$125**
- **Best Mixed Media \$125**
