1. Determine eligibility:
  - ✓ SOYRA member
  - ✓ Artwork previously exhibited at the Aurora Cultural Centre not eligible
  - ✓ Artwork must be available for sale
2. For a non-refundable fee of \$40.00, you may enter 2 recent (2018 - 2019) original works of any media with a max. Width of 48".

3. Email submission:

    4. In a **short statement of 60 – 80 words**, please express how your work responds to the theme. The statement is for the community to connect with your art and is not part of the jurying process.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

### ACCEPTED WORK & SIZE LIMITS

**Hanging work must weigh less than 27 lbs and must not exceed 48" in total width.** Wet paintings, faulty wiring and insecure framing will not be accepted. The jury's decision is final and will be announced by Friday November 15, 2019. **Artists chosen by the jury will be paid an exhibition fee by the Aurora Cultural Centre at the conclusion of the exhibit.** Work submitted to the exhibition must be as it appears in the submitted files or it may not be included. By entering this exhibition, artists agree to provide digital images of the accepted work for educational, publicity and archival purposes. No work may be removed from the exhibition until closing.

### INSURANCE

Aurora Cultural Centre will insure works while on the premises until artwork pickup day. Beyond the timelines of the exhibition, artists are responsible for insuring their work.

### DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND PICK-UP

Packing, delivery and pick-up of artwork equipment is the responsibility of the artist. At the conclusion of the exhibition, all unsold artwork must be promptly retrieved. There is no storage available. Your curator will take all the reasonable care during the hanging, showing and take down of the exhibition.

All accepted two-dimensional works must be delivered ready to hang with D-hooks screwed in 3 inches below the top of the art piece (dependent on size of work; please connect with [clare@auroraculturalcentre.ca](mailto:clare@auroraculturalcentre.ca) if there are uncertainties). All three-dimensional works must be suitably prepared with supports, hanging devices and, if needed, instructions for installation.

### SALES

Aurora Cultural Centre will charge a sales commission of 40% on all works sold as a result of participating in this exhibition.
